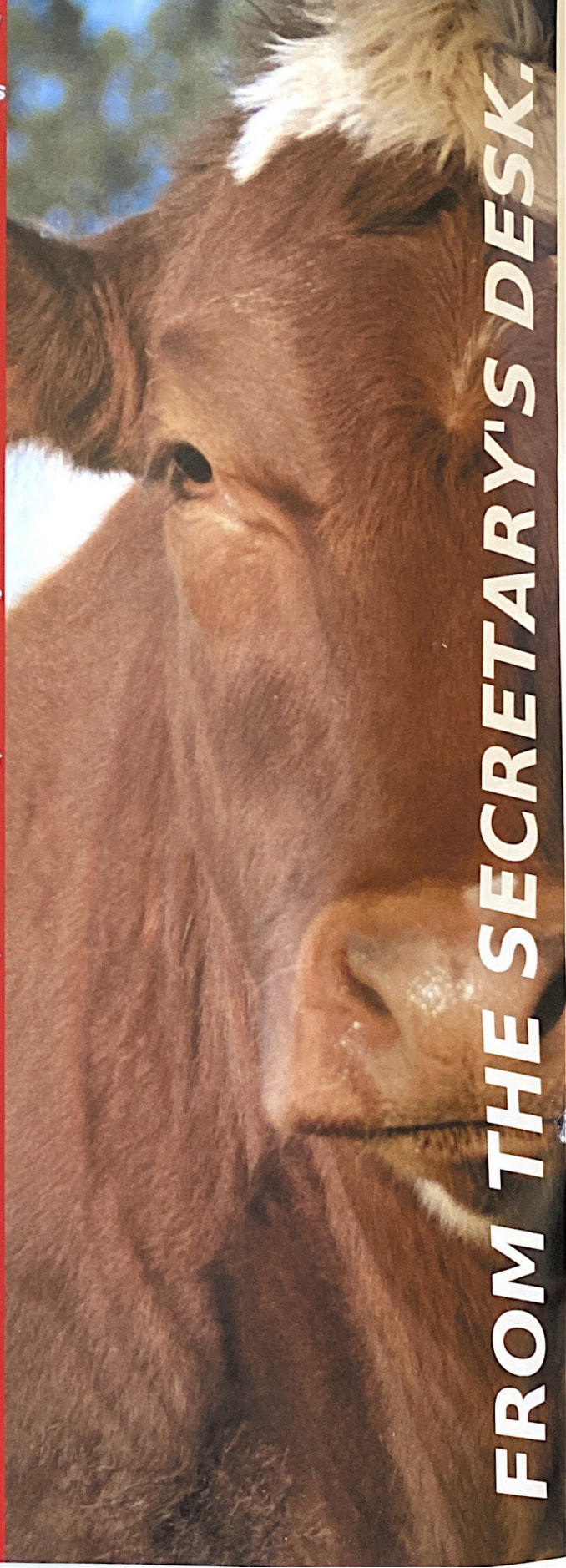

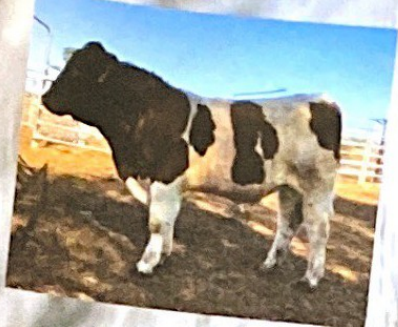
Finally, the AGM for the society will be held during July and I will forward nomination forms for directors etc to members late May.

OBITUARY

GRAHAM POTTIE 28/03/1930 TO 2/01/2020

Graham was born at 'Bellevue' Larg on the Paterson River near Maitland. Graham's parents **made** their home at 'Claremont' Ryde and he went to school in Sydney, with his high school **days** spent at The King's School. During his school holidays Graham spent a lot of time on his uncle Jack's dairy farm. It was here that he developed his **love** of jersey cattle, which finally led to his 20 **year** career in milking cows for a living.

He married Ailsa, on 7th February, **1959** and **together** they made their home where they **raised 3** children, Douglas, James and Angus.

In 1973, Graham and his brother sold the dairies and bought 'Pembroke' on the Merriwa lease. His Road in the Upper Hunter to raise the cattle. They then sold Pembroke and moved to their present home at 'Turrawonga' north of Maitland.

Graham bred Shorthorns and Maine Anjou Friesians many years and **was a** terrific judge of cattle. He loved nothing better than showing people around his herd and discussing the Maine Anjou breed... with them. Graham and Ailsa's door was always open to anyone that wished to drop in.

He will be greatly missed by all that knew him.

Morham Maines and Heartland Maines will represent the Society with a line up of cattle.

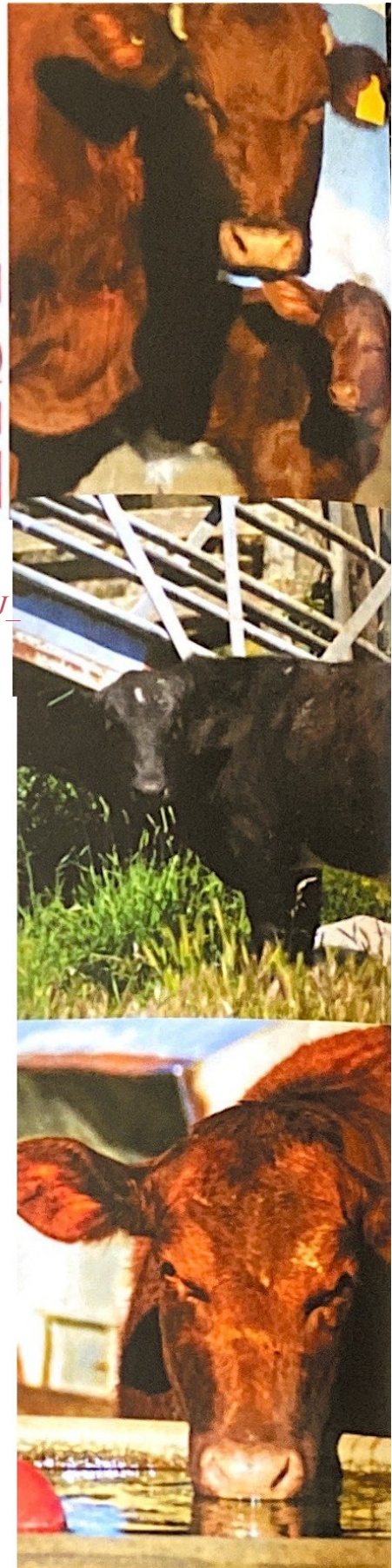
The exhibit is an opportunity for the public to view and become familiar with Maine Anjou cattle.
